Introduction

The Registration, Evaluation, Authorization, and Restriction of Chemicals Regulation (Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006) governs the production and use of chemical substances to protect human health and the environment (“REACH”). Additionally, REACH includes specific requirements for Substances of Very High Concern (“SVHC”), which relate to chemicals identified as potentially harmful.

Oregon Tool (the “Company”) is committed to REACH and SVHC compliance and expects the same dedication from all suppliers.

This Policy applies to the Company and all Company’s suppliers.

Purpose

This Registration, Evaluation, Authorization, and Restriction of Chemicals and Substances of Very High Concern Policy (“Policy”) establishes guidelines for compliance expectations at Oregon Tool.

Policy

The REACH Regulation requires manufacturers and importers to identify and manage risks linked to the substances they produce and market in the EU, ensuring safe use throughout their supply chains. REACH includes specific requirements for SVHC, which are chemicals identified as potentially harmful due to properties such as carcinogenicity, mutagenicity, reproductive toxicity, or environmental persistence. SVHCs are published by the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) in the Candidate List and are subject to strict obligations regarding notification, communication, and authorization.

The Company requires all suppliers to comply with REACH and SVHC requirements, including the identification, registration, and communication of SVHCs present in products or packaging. Suppliers must provide proper documentation, such as updated safety data sheets, declarations of conformity, and any relevant evidence to demonstrate compliance upon request.

Compliance

The Company regularly reviews all documentation provided by its suppliers to ensure continued adherence and transparency within our supply chain.

Oregon Tool policies are intended to comply with the law. If there is conflict between a policy and applicable law, the law will apply.
